#### Our New Reward System - Class Dojo

This year, we're introducing an exciting new reward system based on Class Dojo.

Class Dojo is an online platform where teachers can award points to children for positive behaviour, effort, and achievements in school. Parents can also see their child's progress, helping to celebrate successes together. More information to follow on this.

Over the course of the year, as children collect Dojo points, they can work towards special awards:

- 50 points BRONZE Award School pencil
- 100 points SILVER Award School pen
- 200 points GOLD Award School special prize
- 300 points PLATINUM Award School special prize

#### **Weekly Celebration Assemblies**


