Wraparound care



Wraparound Care - Important Booking Changes

We would like to inform all parents and carers of some important changes to the way wraparound care bookings are managed. From now on, all bookings must be made by 12pm on the Friday before the week you wish your child to attend. This advance booking system allows us to ensure we have appropriate staffing levels in place and can maintain the highest standards of safeguarding for all children attending.

Please note that bookings made after this time will not be accepted.

We also now have a **dedicated email address** for wraparound care: wraparoundcare@milborneport.acexcellence.co.uk

All bookings **must** be made through this email. Any requests made via other email addresses, phone calls, or messages will not be processed. Once you email your booking request, you will receive an automatic reply confirming that your message has been received and that the office will contact you to confirm your booking. This email will also include the **wraparound care mobile number**, which can be used for **urgent contact after school hours only** (please note that bookings cannot be made via this number).

Thank you for your continued support and cooperation as we make these improvements to ensure the safety and smooth running of our wraparound care provision.

As many of you know, our children absolutely love spending their lunchtimes on the school field during the warmer months.
